IMPACT



Greyston's Open Hiring business model generates approximately \$11.5 million in overall economic impact annually in Southwest Yonkers.



Each Greyston Bakery Open Hire results in over \$30,000 in public savings annually.



In 2019, Greyston provided job opportunities to 196 individuals who previously were deemed "unemployable."



Since fall 2019, Greyston's Center for Open Hiring has facilitated employment of over 600 people nationwide through partners such as The Body Shop.



Last year, Greyston Workforce Development graduates earned approximately 31% over minimum wage after job placement. Those placed in employment in 2019 will generate about \$2.2 million in public savings annually.



Since 2017, the Greyston Rangers apprenticeship program has provided training to 145 returning citizens.



Since 2012, Greyston's Youth Program has provided nationally credentialed job skills training to 187 young adults, 126 of whom have secured permanent employment.



Greyston's Community Gardens program offers 5,000 local community members free access to 12 gardens yielding tons of organic produce each year. Our work extends beyond these public green spaces to collaborative learning experiences and educational activities for Yonkers youth and their families.
